International E-Care Rules TESDA Synchronized Exam for Caregivers.

The International E-Care Batch 1 Caregiver Students recently ruled the Synchronized Competency Assessment examination for Caregivers held last March 7 this city. The test was administered by TESDA on three (3) areas simultaneously - Malolos City, Sta. Maria, and Baliuag towns, all in the province of Bulacan. The test was given to assess the knowledge part for the Caregiver Licensure Exam. The skills part shall be administered on a later date.

The E-Care team bagged the highest honors getting not only the highest school percentage passing at 93.3%, but the highest individual scores also. Fourteen (14) out of the 15 students who took the exams passed on first take. Mr. Cicero de Leon and Ms. Daisy Santos, both from E-Care, got the highest individual marks.

Based on official results from TESDA, only 23 students passed the assessment examinations and fourteen (14) were from the E-Care Team. The E-Care students account for 60% of all successful examinees.

International E-Care was founded only last year and accredited under the new TESDA rules on Training Regulations. Their training center is located at Guinhawa Subdivision in the City of Malolos.
